

# MEN

All cast members must put on their own make up base before sitting for the makeup crew.

1. Brush brown eye shadow over entire lid. Do not extend beyond end of eye.
2. Apply black pencil to eyebrow. Make eyebrows straight, do not curve. If brows are bushy or have white/gray hair, use black mascara to color brows.
3. Apply a thin line of black eyeliner under eye. Add two straight lines at the corner of the eye, just beyond the eye (will look like an equal sign).
4. Run the white pencil between the two straight lines.
5. Blush should go straight across the cheek, applied moderately.
6. Lips are a shade of brown. If the cast member does not have own lipstick, give him one to keep from the big kit. Lipstick should be applied to make the lips look thin, and without making the bow in the upper lip. If the man has full lips, do not apply lipstick to the end of the lip.
